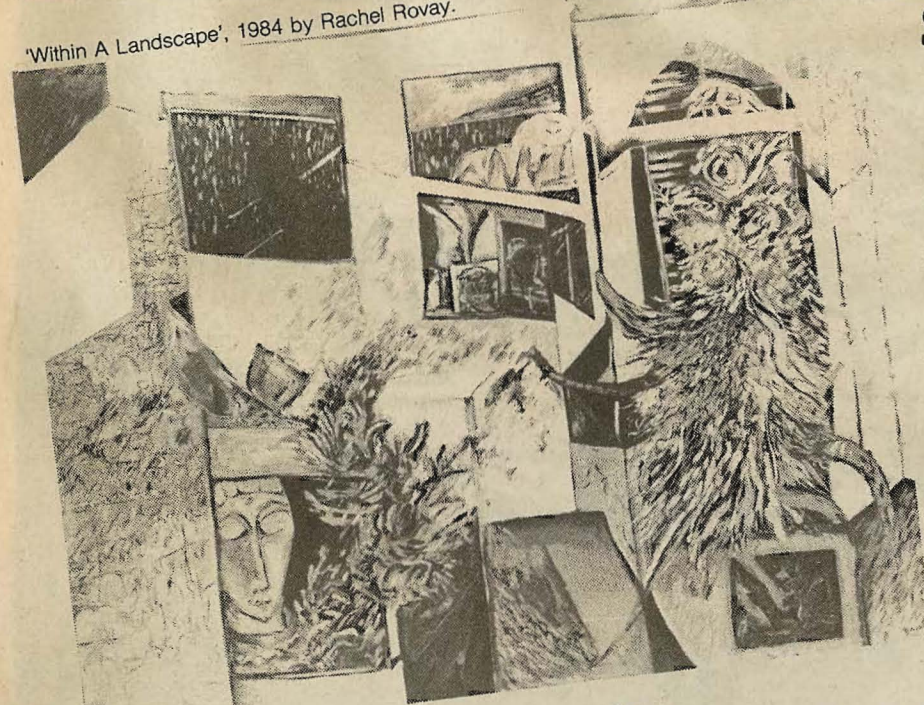

The Exhibition will provide a unique opportunity to see collections by leading contemporary Melbourne artists who share an intimate association with the Port Melbourne area.

Works will be shown by Jenny Bannister, fashion designer and clothier; Dale Evans of the Biltmoderne design studio which recently received the prestigious Royal Australian Institute of Architects Award 1985, for the most outstanding commercial renovation (Inflation Night Club); paintings by Bern Emmerichs; textile designs by Sue Cummings; glass works by Gerhard Emmerichs and a miscellaneous collection of works by Tom Sapontsis who designed the 1985 and 1986 Festival artwork.

The second group of exhibiting artists are all painters and include works by Vivienne Sharklewit, Kevin Parratt, Rachel Rovay, Beverly Martorana, Peter Cambell and Jim Patterson. Bill Bishop, a long time resident of Port Melbourne, will be showing a collection of watercolours depicting waterfront scenes of Port Melbourne and Williamstown on Saturday, February 22.
